History & Overview of VNY

This presentation describes how Van Nuvs Airport (VNY) has evolved since it opened in 1928 as Metropolitan Airport on 80 acres of trees and farmland in the rustic San Fernando Valley. Over the years, the airport became a popular location for Hollywood



film-making, a center for aviation business and services and even a World War II military base. Today, VNY plays an important role in the regional approach to meeting passenger demand through leadership in general aviation, business and community service. An economic impact study found the airport supports over 12,300 jobs and contributes \$1.3 billion annually to the Southern California economy.

Airport Security & Safety

With fully trained police officers on duty 24 hours a day, VNY maintains an excellent security record. We take pride in being a leader in general aviation security by maintaining a tenant watch program, an open line of communication with airport neighbors and operators, and recent security enhancements. VNY is proud to be one of the nation's leaders in general aviation security.

As a covered entity under Title II of the American Disabilities Act, the City of Los Angeles does not discriminate on the basis of disability and, upon request, will provide reasonable accommodation to ensure equal access to its programs, services and activities.

Airfield Operations

Around the clock, VNY operations staff works closely with the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), pilots, airport tenants, public safety personnel and others to remain in compliance with federal standards and ensure smooth operations in both routine and emergency situations.



Aviation Careers

There is an abundance of aviation and nonaviation careers located at VNY. Jobs vary depending on preferred work environments; in an aircraft, a workshop, an office or on the ground. Several major aviation service companies are



located at the airport, offering everything from flight training and aircraft maintenance to flight charters and hangars or tie-down areas for aircraft storage.

Noise Management Programs

Learn about the airport's mandatory and voluntary noise management programs and how the airport employs the same technology used by the FAA to monitor air traffic. Virtually all arrivals and departures are tracked through VNY's noise management office.

Community Outreach Programs

Community outreach is an important priority for airport management. VNY provides information on airport policies, programs and procedures through a variety of community relations programs, including speaking engagements, free airport tours, exhibits, community events, and educational activities. We also coordinate monthly meetings of the VNY Citizens Advisory Council to receive input on airport related issues and programs, and we support the Friends of Van Nuys Airport, whose members share a common interest in aviation.
