
Meet the New Officer in Charge of Airport Police


VNY Hosts 12th Annual Aviation Careers Education (ACE) Academy


FAA To Provide Upgrade to Electrical Lines


Aeroplex/Aerolease Group Commences \$7.5 Million Development


Prop Park Opens Its Doors to the Community



VNY Briefs

Airport Updates at a Glance

Sherman Way Tunnel - A huge thank you to Los Angeles City Councilwoman Nury Martinez, District 6, and staff for working successfully with the Bureau of Street Services to have the Sherman Way tunnel cleaned on the first Tuesday of every month.

Airport Tree Study - To improve airport safety, LAWA will begin collecting data south of the airport near the Van Nuys Golf Course to determine if any trees are obstructing VNY arrival or departure surfaces.

Pavement Management Plan - LAWA has engaged a consulting firm to update VNY's Pavement Management Plan. Non-destructive testing of concrete and asphalt areas, last conducted in 2010, is expected to commence in August. Tenants will be notified of requests to access their leaseholds.

Perimeter Security Fence Project - VNY has completed Phase I of its new Perimeter Security Enhancement Project. Shrubbery, plants and trees obscuring gates and fences have been removed, approximately 56 percent of access gates have been closed, and razor wire has been installed on new sections of the perimeter fence.

Super Scoopers Arrival - Two CL-415 Super Scooper fire-fighting aircraft arrived at VNY on August 6, about 3 weeks ahead of schedule, to provide assistance during the wildfire season. The aircraft are leased from Quebec by the City of Los Angeles Fire Department and are expected to remain at VNY through September. Two Erickson Air-Crane helicopters are also at VNY to provide support during wildfire season.



About Van Nuys Airport:

VNY is one of three airports owned and operated by Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA), a self-supporting branch of the City of Los Angeles, governed by a seven-member Board of Airport Commissioners who are appointed by the mayor and approved by the Los Angeles City Council. One of the world's busiest general aviation airports, VNY serves as a valued San Fernando Valley resource, providing ongoing leadership in general aviation, business and community service. Dedicated to noncommercial air travel, VNY had over 217,000 operations in 2015. More than 100 businesses are located on the 730-acre airport, including three major fixed base operators and numerous aviation service companies.

Annually, the airport contributes approximately \$1.3 billion to the Southern California economy and supports over 12,000 jobs. In addition, VNY provides programs to benefit local residents, along with educational initiatives and aviation-related career and training opportunities.
