I am especially pleased to announce the findings of a new VNY Economic Impact Study conducted to by the Los Angeles County Economic Development Corporation. Based on 2015 activity, the airport contributes \$2 billion to the local economy, supports 10,480 jobs and generates \$673.4 million in labor income annually. VNY is a tax generator, not a tax user, and produces \$170.1 million in federal and \$124.7 million in state and local taxes per year.

In the year ahead, I look forward to seeing continued progress on major projects that will create high-skilled jobs, strengthen the airport's infrastructure and fuel the regional economy. Airport staff will also continue to partner with airport businesses to enhance safety and security, and to work closely with stakeholders in the local community.

Again, thank you for your continued involvement and support. Together, I am certain we can make great progress in 2017!


