As you are aware, the final milestone date contained within Ordinance 181,106 is approaching and will become effective on **January 1, 2016**. Specifically the provision of significant note is that which pertains to noise levels of aircraft that will no longer be permitted to operate at Van Nuys Airport (VNY) as of the above stated date.

As this date is rapidly approaching, it is highly recommended that all tenants, subtenants, airport stakeholders and users re-familiarize themselves with the stipulations contained within the VNY Airport Curfew and Noise Abatement Ordinances, as amended, especially with regard to the upcoming milestones contained therein.

Most notably the following sections will become effective (exemptions become null and void) and enforced by the Los Angeles City Attorney's Office as of January 1, 2016:

- **Ordinance 181,106; Section 5.2 (d);** No Aircraft may arrive or depart the airport on or after January 1, 2016 whose AC36-3 takeoff noise level equals or exceeds 77 dBA.
- **Ordinance 181,106; Section 5.3(g)(2);** Military aircraft of types first flown on or after January 1, 1950, shall be exempt from the provisions of Section 5.2 of the regulation until January 1, 2016.
- **Ordinance 181,106; Section 5.3 (h);** Repair and Maintenance: Until January 1, 2016, exemptions shall be provided to aircraft conducting operations associated with performance of major repairs or major alternations, required maintenance inspections related to major repairs or major alterations, or systems installations and warranty work (collectively, "work"):
