Subject: SID Altitude compliance

IFR clearances issued by VNY ATCT specify initial departure via a Standard Instrument Departure (SID).

Conventional VNY RWY 16R SIDs contain an altitude restriction: at or below 1700 at the FIM R-102 or VNY 2.2 DME.

RNAV VNY RWY 16R SIDs contain an altitude restriction: at or below 1750 at the VNY 1.5 DME.

When VNY Clearance Delivery issues such clearances, the tower normally instructs the pilot to "maintain four thousand, expect (filed altitude) ten minutes after departure."

Pilots of departing aircraft are expected to comply with SID altitude restrictions regardless of the initial assigned altitude(s).
