Subject: Letter from VNY ATCT Re: Hold Short Instructions at Intersections

Greetings,

I wanted to send a quick reminder of when a controller instructs a pilot to hold short of an intersection. Please do not turn into that intersection. The reason is to keep that intersection open for exiting aircraft, or in the case of "K" on the "B" side, to protect the departure path of RWY16L.

Example coming from the southwest corner.

- RWY16L taxi via A, Q, B, hold short of Q. That means do not turn into Q, You will stop prior to Q.
- If the controller instructs.
 RWY16L taxi via A, Q, B, Hold short of RWY16R. then you can turn into the intersection because you're holding short of RWY16R

Another example on "B"

- If the controller instructs.
 - Taxi southbound on "B" hold short of "K". You do not turn into "K". That is a dangerous position to hold due to the RWY16L departures and is the reason why we instruct to hold short of "K".
- If instructed to hold short of RWY16R at "K". Then you are expected to turn into "K" and hold short of RWY16R.

The tower has been having situations lately because aircraft are not holding at the proper place and the trailing aircraft must be sent around due to the runway not being cleared.
