Van Nuys Airport Youth Leadership Airport Academy Celebrates Final Session

Youth participants receive recognition from local officials in celebration of program completion

VAN NUYS, Calif. — On April 26, Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA), in partnership with Los Angeles City Council District 6 and the City of Los Angeles Youth Development Department, successfully concluded the Van Nuys Airport (VNY) Youth Leadership Airport Academy (YLAA), with a special recognition ceremony honoring participants for their completion of the program. The final session focused on empowering youth advocacy in leadership and encouraging participants to envision their impact through civic engagement and potential aviation career pathways.

The culminating session featured Los Angeles Councilmember Imelda Padilla (District 6), who presented certificates to the students in recognition of their achievements. Darby Whipple, Associate Director of Infrastructure-Airport, Office of the Mayor and Sheldon Cruz, the Director of Strategic Partnerships & Government, Youth Development Department also participated in the ceremony, providing

information about future opportunities for community involvement and professional development.
