VAN NUYS AIRPORT IN THE COMMUNITY

NORTH VALLEY OCCUPATIONAL CENTER CAREER EMPOWERMENT ACADEMY TOUR OF VAN NUYS AIRPORT

On June 25, Van Nuys Airport hosted the North Valley Occupational Center's (NVOC) Career Empowerment Academy for a behind-the-scenes tour of the airport. The program is designed to empower youth by offering hands-on experience in aviation maintenance.



This past Wednesday's program featured a tour of VNY, including visits to the General Services Department hangar where LAPD helicopters are maintained and repaired, LAFD 114 Station for firefighting air operations, and VNY tenants Clay Lacy and StandardAero. A future field trip will include a tour of Los Angeles International Airport.

This program solidifies VNY as a space for youth empowerment and career development. Initiatives like NVOC's aviation mechanic program lay the foundation for a future generation of innovators and leaders in the aviation industry.

VNY ADVANCES SUSTAINABLE AVIATION WITH FUEL FEE WAIVER FOR UNLEADED GAS

Earlier this month, the Los Angeles Board of Airport Commissioners (BOAC) waived the \$0.11 per gallon fuel delivery fee for unleaded aviation gasoline. This policy update incentivizes a switch from leaded aviation gasoline to cleaner-burning, unleaded alternatives.



This policy change is the latest in a series of VNY policies geared to reduce emissions. Earlier this year, the airport became the first general aviation airport in the country to adopt a policy and incentive program that aims to transition all ground support equipment vehicles to zero-emission models by 2030.

The latest policy modification is a step toward clean aviation that builds off growing efforts in the industry to reduce environmental impact and is part of VNY's larger commitment to sustainability and environmental stewardship.

VAN NUYS AIRPORT MANAGER HONORED AS 2025 CLASS OF THE VALLEY 200

Our very own Van Nuys Airport Airport Manager, Jacob Haik, was recently honored as one of Los Angeles Business Journal's Inside The Valley magazine's 2025 Class of the Valley 200. The issue features 200 of the most influential people throughout the Valley.



Haik, who began his role as Airport Manager in September 2024, has led several first-of-its-kind environmental initiatives, including the airport's inaugural Green Tenant Program, the development of sustainable operational guidelines, and a bold commitment to making VNY the first general aviation airport to achieve zero emissions by 2030.

Under his leadership, VNY also earned Level 4 accreditation in the Airports Council International Europe's Airport Carbon Accreditation program, making it the first general aviation airport in the Americas to be certified at Level 4 or higher.

Before stepping into his current role, Haik served as LAWA's Director of Sustainability and Compliance. His career spans more than two decades in government, community affairs, and executive management.
